Program Completion Rate (PCR) is the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length of 24 months compared with the number of students who initially begin the program (ACMH School of Radiologic Technology benchmark is 80% or greater annually)

The JRCERT defines “not actively seeking employment” as: 1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts; OR 2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation; OR 3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours; OR 4) Graduate is on active military duty; OR 5) Graduate is continuing education.
