Community Programs and Funding

HEALTHY Armstrong — In collaboration with the Armstrong School District, Children's Community Care Pediatrics, and UPMC Health Plan, the ACMH Hospital is providing wellness education and fitness resources enabling our children to understand and choose healthy lifestyles. The ACMH Hospital Foundation is proud to provide funding and leadership for this initiative. Vision Exams — Understanding the positive link between healthy vision and enhanced learning, the Foundation sponsors comprehensive vision exams for uninsured local children. Now, any uninsured student in grades K-6 in Armstrong School District will receive his or her education with healthy eyes.

Cancer Center Assistance — This fund assists eligible cancer patients by underwriting uninsured costs associated with their cancer treatment.

Cancer Center Education — To provide our cancer patients with outstanding nursing care, this fund enables ACMH cancer nurses to learn the most cutting-edge techniques available in cancer treatment.

Cancer Center Outreach — Free screenings, education and support programs offer eligible area citizens the opportunity to stop cancer before it begins or to detect cancer in its earliest stages when treatment is highly effective.

Oncology Protocol — The Oncology Protocol is a program unique to ACMH Hospital that offers cancer patients the opportunity to take part in pharmaceutical research trials specific to their diagnosis. ACMH Hospital is proud to have this benefit available, giving our patients an individualized edge in conquering their cancer.
